

The Central Bank of Seychelles participates in the Global Money Week

Global Money Week is a global awareness celebration coordinated by the Child and Youth Finance International. The Global Money Week consists of a series of activities geared towards engaging children, youth and their communities in learning about financial education and financial inclusion.

Following the launching of the National Financial Education Strategy and in line with its initiative to educate the population of Seychelles on Financial Education and its importance, the Central Bank of Seychelles (CBS) in collaboration with the UN Youth Seychelles organised for a group of students of secondary school and SALS students to visit CBS' premises on the occasion of the Global Money Week on Wednesday 14th march, 2018.

The students aged 16 to 18 attended presentations from several divisions within the CBS, namely Research and Statistics Division, Financial Surveillance Division, Financial Inclusion and Market Conduct Division, Financial Markets Division and the Banking Services Division. Through the presentations the students got the chance to understand the main objectives of the CBS and its contribution towards the economy of Seychelles in promoting domestic price stability and to maintain a sound financial system.
